

Cancer Immunotherapy and 2018 Nobel Prize in Medicine

Emin Kansu graduated from Hacettepe University Medical School in 1970 with "İhsan Doğramacı Valedictorian Award". He completed Internal Medicine residency in 1974 and Hematology subspecialty in 1978 at the Thomas Jef erson University in Philadelphia. He became an Associate Professor in 1979 and Professor in 1988 at Hacettepe University, where he established the Department of Basic Oncology and served as its director for more than two decades.

Dr. Kansu served as a member of the Higher Education Council representing the Inter University Council between 1988-1992, and the European Union and European Science Commission Ethics Work Group between 1992-1996. In 2002, he established the Stem Cell Transplantation Unit of Hacettepe University Oncology Institute.

Dr. Kansu is the recipient of 1979 TÜBİTAK Incentive Award, 1985 Sedat Simavi Health Sciences Award, 1987 Eczacıbaşı Science Award and 1997 TÜBİTAK Science Award. He serves as the President of the International Society of Hematology (ISH-EAD) since 2014 and General Secretary of the European & African Branch of the same organization since 1996. He is a Principle and Honorary Member of the Turkish Academy of Sciences (TÜBA).
